Privacy Statement

Hackney U3A requires members to provide their personal information so that you can be kept informed about events and activities that are offered as part of your membership.

In collecting your information Hackney U3A will:

- Store it securely.
- Use it to manage the activities of the U3A and communicate with you as a U3A member.
- Share your information with group leaders/conveners for those groups in which you are a member.
- Send you general information about the Third Age Trust*.

*The Third Age Trust is the national office to which all U3As are affiliated.

Code of conduct

As members of Hackney u3a:

- We treat each other with dignity and respect, whatever a person's heritage and background, faith, sexuality, gender or political persuasion, and how they are differently abled.
- We understand the guiding Principles of the Hackney u3a and agree to follow them.
- We seek to act in the best interests of the u3a.
- We realise the importance of using u3a resources responsibly in accordance with the principles of the U3A movement.

Principles of the U3A Movement

The U3A Movement is non-religious and non-political and has three main principles:

The Third Age Principle

Membership of a U3A is open to all in their third age, which is defined not by a particular age but by a period in life in which full-time employment has ceased. Members promote the values of lifelong learning and the positive attributes of belonging to a U3A. Members should do all they can to ensure that people wanting to join a U3A can do so.

The Self-help Learning Principle

Members form interest groups covering a wide range of topics and activities; by the members, for the members. No qualifications are required, sought or offered. Learning is for its own sake, for enjoyment. There is no distinction between the learners and the teachers; they are all u3a members.

The Mutual Aid Principle

Each U3A is a mutual aid organisation, operationally independent but a member of The Third Age Trust and follows the guiding principles of the U3A movement. Payments are not normally made to members for services rendered to any U3A. Each U3A is self-funded with membership subscriptions and costs kept as low as possible. Outside financial assistance should only be sought if it does not imperil the integrity of the U3A movement.
